



So shines a good deed in a weary world."






- **15.** Students are expected to reach school on time. Three late arrivals shall lead to disciplinary action. Students, who come to the school by private transport, should reach the school at least ten minutes before the school timings.
- **16.** No student of the school is allowed to drive a mechanized vehicle to school. Any student found using the same may be rusticated from the school.
- 17. Students are not allowed to offer any personal gift or presents to the staff members.
- **18.** Broad, fancy and sharp edged kara is not allowed.
- **19.** Students must participate in all the co-curricular activities, for which they will be assessed and awarded grades.
- **20.** The observance of the school rules, desirable code of conduct and good behaviour is an essential condition for the student's continuance in the school. In case a student violates the school rules or indulges in any form of indiscipline, strict action such as expulsion/suspension/restriction will be taken against the student.
- **21.** Chewing gums are strictly prohibited in the school campus and bus.

School Uniform and Appearance

- 1. School uniform is compulsory for all the students. Students will not be allowed to attend the school without proper uniform.
- 2. Students must attend the school in a neat, clean and proper school uniform.
 - i. Low/high waist, short skirts for girls and low waist trousers with narrow or broad bottom for boys are not permitted.
 - ii. Girls should wear knee length skirts.
 - iii. Shirts should be properly tucked in.
- **3.** Uniform accessories such as belt, necktie, gloves, Identity card etc. are equally important for a smart uniform turn out and hence students must wear them.
- 4. Students must wear House Uniform on all Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- **5.** On every working day, during school functions and outings, students should be in the school uniform. Wearing the school uniform is obligatory on such occasions.
- 6. Students must wear black sports shoes both in summer and winter. Leather shoes are not allowed.
- 7. Girls should wear only white undershirts and boys should wear white vests under the shirt.
- 8. It is mandatory for girls to wear black cycling shorts under the skirt.



School Transport Rules

- 1. School transport will be available depending on the number of students from a particular location/route. Further, students will be picked up from the nodal points. Request for any home drop or pick up will not be entertained.
- 2. Routes are mapped according to the feasibility of plying the School Bus in the area and also keeping in view the safety of the students.
- 3. For seeking any permanent change in the bus route/ stoppage in the middle of the session, Parents/ Guardians must request the school in writing at least a week in advance. Such a request will be subject to the availability of seats in the bus plying on that route.
- 4. Students should reach their bus stoppages at least five minutes early. Buses will leave at the time stipulated for the bus stop and will not wait for those who come late.
- 5. Students will be held responsible for any damage caused to the buses due to their negligence or mischievous behaviour and will be liable to strict disciplinary action and penalty by the school.
- 6. Students are required to sit on the seats allotted to them in the bus. Anyone found violating the seating arrangement or indulging in untoward activity will not be allowed to travel by the school transport.
- 7. Students are not allowed to eat anything while travelling in the bus.
- 8. Disciplinary action will be taken against the students found littering in the bus.
- **9.** The children should stay away from the main road until the bus arrives and should not rush towards the bus.
- 10. Students should not run around or lean out of the windows in the moving bus.
- 11. Unruly/Indisciplined behaviour like screaming and shouting in the bus or bullying others is not permitted. Bus facility will be immediately discontinued in case the child is found to be involved in any such incident.

Leave, Absence and Withdrawal

Absence from school disrupts the continuity of the learning process of a child. It is the duty of the parents/guardians to inform the school in advance about the impending absence of their wards from the school. Leave application submitted later will be accepted only under unavoidable circumstances. Certain norms regarding absence have to be observed by the students as well as the parents to maintain discipline and to keep the system of the school in order.

- 1. It is mandatory for the students from Grade IV onwards to maintain at least 85% attendance during the session to enable them to become eligible for appearing in the term-end examinations.
- 2. The students maintaining 100% attendance in the school will be awarded with an Appreciation Certificate.
- **3.** Leave for one day: The leave application should be given at least one day in advance. However, in case of an emergency, the application with reason of absence must be produced when the student comes to the school the next day. Any student who remains absent from school without prior intimation must produce a letter from the parents/guardian addressed to the class teacher, the next day, stating the reason for absence.
- 4. Leave for more than one day:
 - (a) Student who has been on leave for more than one day must give an application stating a valid reason for his/her absence. A medical certificate from a registered medical practitioner must be produced in case of illness.
 - (b) Repeated absence without sanctioned leave or unexplained absence for more than five consecutive days renders the student liable to have his/her name struck off the rolls. Re-admission may be granted only at the discretion of the Principal.

5. It is mandatory for all the students to report to school immediately after the vacations. The school reserves the right to strike off the names of the students from the rolls who do not report within six days.

- 6. If the name of any student has been struck off the rolls twice for any reason, he/she will not be re-admitted to school.
- 7. Absence from Examinations: No marks will be awarded if a student is on leave or absent on the days of examination/tests/assessment/observations.

8. Early/Short Leave:

Short/early leave is not permissible. Only in case of an emergency arising at the school or when the child falls sick in the school, parents will be called up to pickup their ward.

9. A student suffering from the following diseases must observe the prescribed period of quarantine before returning to class:

Chicken Pox	: Until the scabs have fallen off completely
Measles	: Two weeks after the rashes disappear
Mumps	: Until the swelling has subsided completely
Jaundice	: Six weeks after recovery
Conjunctivitis	: Until the swelling and redness in eyes disappear
Respiratory ailments	: Until the child is completely cured

- **10.** Under no circumstances will the child be allowed to be picked up by any relative or neighbour. This is to ensure the safety of the child in view of the vulnerability of children as soft targets for kidnapping or mishappening.
- 11. Students can be asked to leave the school on the following grounds:

Indiscipline

Unsatisfactory progress in academics

12. Withdrawal

A notice of one clear month must be given in case the parents want to withdraw their ward. Fee will not be refunded in such a case.

13. Any document applied for, can be collected from the school's Front Office between 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. only seven days after the written request has been made for the same.







Bullying refers to acts or behaviour when a person is hurt, distressed, harassed, pressured or victimized by repeated intentional attacks by another individual or a group. Bullying may involve physical, textual, social, psychological behaviour.

Following is the list of activities which are strictly prohibited in MMIS:

- 1. Physical: hitting, punching, grabbing, pushing, tripping, pulling hair, biting
- 2. Emotional: being unfriendly, exclusion, tormenting
- 3. Racial: racial taunts, name calling, gestures and graffiti
- 4. Religion: religious taunts, name calling
- 5. Verbal: name calling, sarcasm, putdown, ethnic, casteist or religious insults, physical, social or academic disability insults
- 6. Textual: passing notes, writing on desks/diaries, SMS, E-mail, social media apps
- 7. Social: ignoring, excluding, mimicking, spreading rumors, defaming, breaking possessions



Safe and effective use of internet and digital technology is the prime responsibility of all in today's world.



This may include formal warning, contact with parents, suspension/ expulsion from the school or any other strict action.

Visiting Hours

To facilitate the smooth functioning of the school and to ensure an appropriate participation of the parents/guardians in the learning process of the child, following visiting hours will be observed by the school:

Class/ Subject Teachers	On all PTM days or with prior appointment on other days

- 1. Any change in schedule will be notified.
- 2. Parents/ Guardians are requested not to go directly to the class to meet the teachers. Teachers will not be able to leave their classes to attend to any person. Parents are requested to contact the Reception in this regard for all the possible and immediate help.
- 3. Parent Teacher Meetings will be held periodically. Parents are requested to attend the Parent- Teacher Meetings regularly in the interest of their wards and to help the school serve its stake holders, to the best of its ability.

Infirmary

The school has an infirmary for the students, supervised by a qualified Nurse to provide first aid or immediate help. In case of an emergency, parents shall be intimated immediately.

Parents are requested not to send their ward to school if he/she is sick/not feeling well.

Library

MMIS

The school library is open for all the bonafide students of the school. All the classes are provided with at least one library period per week. Students have to observe the following rules:

- 1. Students must carry their library cards with them while going to the library.
- 2. One book is issued for a period of one week at a time. If the books are returned late without a valid reason, the borrowing facility will be withdrawn for two weeks.
- **3.** Books marked, damaged, disfigured or dog-eared will have to be replaced or paid for by the borrower. In case the book is lost, the borrower has to pay the penalty, which is double the cost of the book.
- 4. Students are expected to adhere to the order in which the books are arranged while picking them up or placing them back on the shelves.
- 5. Students are not allowed to bring their personal books to the library.



In order to inculcate a sense of belongingness, team spirit and healthy competition, students have been divided among the following four houses:



Every student from Grade I onwards is placed in one of the four houses at the time of admission.

Each House is headed by a House Master/Mistress and the House Tutor. House Captains and the Vice Captains are entrusted with various responsibilities. Points are awarded to the houses for their performance in cultural and co–curricular activities, games and sports conducted throughout the year. At the end of the year, the Running Trophy is awarded to the house which secures the highest points in these activities during the session.

Rules at the Swimming Pool

- 1. Swimming is a part of the regular curriculum for all students from Grade I and onwards and the schedule is given and followed class wise.
- 2. The swimming pool is accessible only during the allotted time under the strict supervision of the swimming instructor.
- **3.** The students must seek the permission of the swimming instructor before entering the pool.
- 4. Children will have to carry their own swimming costumes, towels and swimming caps duly labelled with the name, class, section and address in a separate bag.
- 5. All swimmers must wear caps. The beginners must wear red caps.
- 6. Students suffering from any skin ailments will be restrained from using the pool.
- 7. Students should bring a medical certificate if they are not fit to use the swimming pool.
- 8. An experienced and certified coach shall take utmost care of your child during the activity.

Parents should fill up the NOC for swimming and all activities planned by school otherwise their ward will not be permitted to enter the swimming pool.
